Town of Sudbury Sudbury Town Center Improvements

The project included safety improvements for historic Sudbury Center located at the intersection of Route 27 and Concord Road and the adjacent connecting road to Town Hall.

Work began with extensive investigation into existing safety and operational deficiencies that have contributed to an increased accident rate and driver frustration. A public outreach program was established in order to identify public priorities. A number of alternatives for improvement were developed and presented. In balancing the needs of the public, it was established that roadway widening to increase intersection capacity and accommodate heavy cut-through traffic was not a priority in this historic location. Instead, the preferred alternative involved a signalized intersection with improved alignment and sight distance to improve both vehicular and pedestrian safety in an aesthetically pleasing environment.
